GWorks Software

Clerk Parker informed the Mayor and Council about the new upgrade to the Cloud being performed by GWorks. This takes affect after the new year. The price will go from \$2541 a year for the license and support agreement to \$8000. This is due to GWorks costs in the upgrade to their systems. The transitions are tentatively scheduled for May 2025. It is stated that the new system will simplify our financial processes, eliminate manual work & save time.
